**A goal is what you want to happen.**

- It is a broad and lofty statement of general purpose to guide planning.
- A goal should be simple and concise and should include two basic components:
  - Who will be affected, and
  - What will change as a result

**An objective is *how you will know if you reached your goal.***

- Objectives outline in measurable terms the specific changes that will occur in the target population in a given amount of time.
- Objectives narrow the goal by adding “who, what, where, and when:” and also specifies how much, how many or how often.
